The intent of the Hall of Fame is to recognize individuals who have made significant and meaningful contributions to society and/or who have demonstrated outstanding service to The Calverton School. Those selected for the Hall of Fame remain true to the mission of The Calverton School – to instill in students intellectual curiosity, personal responsibility, and a strong work ethic to prepare them for higher education and responsible citizenship. Through their individual pursuits, inductees have a positive reputation and serve as role models and sources of pride to past, present, and future students of The Calverton School.

Criteria for this award are as follows:

- General contribution to society as evidenced by leadership in and service to the community and/or The Calverton School, displayed through outstanding contributions in one or more areas of society, including but not limited to, professional, academic, athletic, artistic, social, and/or personal achievements.
- Above all, the nominee shall serve as a role model for current and future students of The Calverton School.
- For an alumnus to be considered eligible for induction into the Hall of Fame, a candidate must have attended The Calverton School for a minimum of four years, and at least fifteen years shall have elapsed since graduation. A candidate may be nominated posthumously.
