SCHOOL DESCRIPTION AND ACCREDITATION

The Calverton School is an independent, nonsectarian, coeducational college preparatory school dedicated to helping students develop into strong, independent, self-confident individuals with a firm foundation in the liberal arts.

The Calverton School is accredited by the Association of Independent Maryland Schools, The National Association of Independent Schools, and the Maryland Department of Education.

ENROLLMENT

Upper School enrollment is 160.

CURRICULUM AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The Calverton School is strictly college preparatory; all courses are accelerated and rigorous.

Every Calverton student is required to take at least five academic core courses each trimester.

To graduate, each student must complete twenty-three credits and a Senior Internship. Credits must include the following:

- English: 4 cr.
- Mathematics: 3 cr.
- Laboratory Science: 3 cr.
- Physical Education: 1 cr.
- Social Studies: 3cr.
- Foreign Language 3 cr.
- Fine Arts: 1 cr.
- Electives: 5 cr.

SENIOR INTERNSHIP

All students are required to complete a Senior Internship that consists of an in-depth work experience in a professional setting. Students develop their individual internship projects in coordination with their advisors.
