Laptop: All students are expected to have a functional laptop with charger. Either PC or Mac are acceptable; Chromebooks and tablets are not, because they rely on web apps and cannot download Office365. A basic run-of-the-mill computer with WiFi capabilities is fine. Microphone and camera for video conferencing usually come standard. Calverton will provide a subscription to Microsoft Office 365.

Laptop Case: Because students do not carry backpacks during the school day, a padded laptop bag or a computer case is highly advisable.

For 8th graders: Graphing calculator: TI-84 (any version: Plus, Plus CE, or Silver Edition) is recommended. If students have access to a hand-me-down graphing calculator, that should be sufficient. (Write name in Sharpie inside battery compartment.)
