**Laptop:** All students are expected to have a functional laptop with a charger, PC or Mac is acceptable; Chromebooks and tablets are not, because they rely on web apps and cannot download Office365. A basic run-of-the-mill computer with WiFi capabilities is fine. Calverton will provide a subscription to Microsoft Office 365.

**Laptop Case:** Because students do not carry backpacks during the school day, a padded laptop bag or a computer case is highly advisable.

**Ear buds/headphones:** For use with computer, only when/if video conferencing in class.

**For 8<sup>th</sup> graders: Graphing calculator:** TI-84 Plus CE (color graphing calculator) is recommended. If students have access to a hand-me-down graphing calculator, that should be sufficient. (Write name in Sharpie inside battery compartment.)
