Visual Arts Journal – The exact sketchbook you use is up to you, but I strongly suggest a hard cover bound sketchbook that is at least 9x12 inches. You want something sturdy and big enough to hold and protect all your work. The Canson sketchbook from Blick Art item # 10350-1011 is a good choice.</li> </ol> <p>Home art supplies – Drawing pencils, colored pencils, pens, and maybe a small watercolor palette or supply of acrylic paints. Since you will be working at home over the summer, gather some basic art supplies you want to have available when working in your Visual Arts Journal. You can find a wide variety of inexpensive core supplies on Amazon or any arts craft store.</p> <p>File folder, binder, and/or large flat file portfolio to keep handouts, loose sketches and artworks, etc.</p>
