

MERIT SCHOLARSHIP CHECKLIST

- Student applicants should fill out the scholarship application, compose and submit an essay supporting his/her Scholarship quest.
 - Paper should be addressed to Calverton's Scholarship Committee.
 - Paper should state why he/she should be awarded a scholarship from The Calverton School.
 - You may type the paper and submit it as an attachment to your scholarship application.
- One letter of recommendation submitted
 - Applicant should demonstrate exemplary character evidenced through a high character reference from an individual not related to the student and also display strong academic excellence.
 - Applicant must be committed to involvement in extracurricular or co-curricular activities and demonstrate a strong commitment to attend college upon graduation.
 - Student must exemplify strong academic excellence.
- ❖ Student should attach most recent report card to demonstrate current academic excellence. This does not apply to current Calverton 8th grade students applying for scholarship—we will pull the most recent report card on your behalf.
- Turn in completed application and all supporting documents to the Office of Admissions by:
 - January 9 new applicants to Grades 9, 10, or 11
 - Adherence to deadline dates is imperative as scholarships are awarded on a first come, first serve basis after the initial deadline for consideration.
 Even for qualifying students, we cannot guarantee that funds will be available beyond the due date.
