**Discipline Policy for Extended Day:** When a child is having a difficult time getting along with others, or when inappropriate behavior is causing a problem, a “time-out” may be necessary. The “time-out” is determined by the age of the child and will be based on one minute for each year. When the “time-out” is over, the child will be redirected to another activity of his/her choice. If a child continues to be disruptive or makes unwise choices, another “time-out” may be required and a staff member will discuss the problem with the parent.
